PTA Volunteer Opportunities

1. Fall Carnival

Time commitment: This is our biggest fundraiser of the year. It involves busy planning (on site and off site) from 9/1-10/13, then full day of preparation on the day of 10/13.

Subcommittees:

- Sponsorships: outreach to community partners (restaurants, stores) to fundraise cash or in-kind donations
- Food: menu and budget planning. Food preparation and cleanup on the day of event.
- Games: organize and install carnival games. General operational maintenance.
- Volunteer: help recruit and organize over 100 volunteers
- Prizes: organize and purchase items as prizes for students to redeem. Run the prize booth on the day of the event.

2. Visual arts classroom support

Time commitment: A few hours a week on site for the school year

Responsibility: Each class has 10 weeks of integrated art during the school year. Parent volunteer(s) would provide classroom support in the art room.

3. Community outreach/Fundraising

Time commitment: Off site. Ongoing.

Responsibility: outreach to community members and local business to establish partnerships (WL Eats), solicit cash or in-kind donations for event sponsorships.

4. Communications/Volunteer Recruitment

Time commitment: Ongoing/As needed

Responsibility: outreach to school community to increase parent volunteering at events. Organize volunteers when needed (Sign-up Genius).

5. Trot-a-Thon and Jog-a-Thon

Time commitment: On site. one day in the fall and one day in the spring, some planning beforehand. Responsibility: Work with Volunteer Recruitment Committee to secure parent volunteers. Organize the event with school staff. Drop off donations after the event.

6. Teacher Appreciation Week

Time Commitment: On site and off site. First week of May and the planning beforehand. Responsibility: organize special events and gifts for teachers and school staff for Teacher Appreciation Week.

7. Book Fair

Time commitment: On site. AM/PM during the weeks of Fall (9/25-9/29) and Spring (4/15-4/19) Book Fairs, and a few meetings before and after

Responsibility: Organize the fair and help students make purchases

8. Library

Time commitment: On site.Bi-weekly: 9-11am Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and/or Thursday. Responsibility: Students visit the library every other week. Each class has a designated hour/day. Parent volunteer help with students to search books and general library maintenance (shelving, cleaning).

9. Gardening

Time Commitment: On site. Flexible but requires consistency

Responsibility: Maintenance of the vegetable gardens at the library and in the kindergarten courtyard
