Chess Club is for students in Grades 2nd thru 6th.

Club Rules: William Land Elementary Chess Club wants all of its members to have fun playing chess.

- 1) There is no eating allowed.
- 2) Always treat each other with courtesy and respect.
- 3) Never say anyone's chess move is dumb.
- 4) Students who continue to disobey the rules will be dropped from the club.
- 5) Students who miss 4 consecutive meetings will be dropped and replaced by the student at the top of the waiting list.

Basic rules and strategies of chess will be given to students:

- 1) How to setup the chess pieces at the beginning of the game.
- 2) How to move each chess piece.
- 3) Introduction to some basic chess openings.
- 4) How to checkmate your opponent's King to win the game.
- 5) How to determine if the game ends with a draw or tie.
- 6) How to use a chess clock during a chess match.
