Course Objectives

- 3. **Learn** elementary music theory concepts.
- 4. **Develop an appreciation** for and understanding of choral music as an art form.
- 5. **Encourage teamwork** and ensemble skills.
- 6. **Provide a safe and enjoyable environment** for musical exploration.

September/October 2024 Introduction to Choir	 Week 1 Introduction to choir, basic warm-up techniques Week 2 Breathing techniques, simple vowel exercises Week 3 Introduction to first song, warm-ups, and breathing Week 4 Review first song, basic music theory (notation, rhythm, etc.) Week 5 Introduction to second song, posture and stage presence Week 6 Articulation and diction, continue with second song
November 2024 Expanding Vocal Technique	 Week 1 Introduction to second song, posture and stage presence Week 2 Articulation and diction, continue with second song Week 3 Vocal health, review first and second song, harmonizing
December 2024 Repertoire Building	 Week 1 Introduction to third song (a short song), warm-ups with scales, Dynamics phrasing in songs Week 2 Emotional expression, review all songs and overview for next semester
