

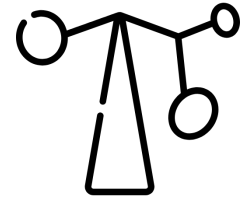
# William Land Sculpture Enrichment Program

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## Brief Description:

This sculpture course will concentrate on development and sculpture ideas through explorations of various materials, techniques and art concepts. Students will take several introductory lectures and demonstrations will take place to help guide students through their sculpture projects. Students will pay close attention to historical and art concepts, with the emphasis of Principles of Design and art/personal vocabulary. At the end of this course, students would have gained and explored with their individual creative expressions.

- Students will create sculptures that clearly express their understanding of principles of design.
- Students will demonstrate an understanding of tools, materials, techniques, and processes.
- Students will show maturity of concept and development of an individual creative voice.
- Students will demonstrate critical thinking skills and complete work with a high level of craftsmanship.
- Students work up to their own ability, pace and sense of commitment.
- Students will develop a body of original artwork in Sculpture.

Students will explore a large range of materials and some materials will be offered and supplied through the instructor.
