ENROLLMENT



- SCUSD kinder enrollment window begins: 1/10/23
- SCUSD kinder enrollment window @ WL: 1/10/23-1/24/23
- All kinder enrollment after 1/24/23: @ SCUSD Enrollment Center
- **Step 1**: Sign up for school tours on school website (available now)
- Step 2: Check school website for updates (availability of enrollment packet)
- Step 3: Pick up enrollment packet from WL
- **Step 4**: Check school website for complete list of documentation needed for enrollment
- <u>Step 5</u>: Schedule for a date/time to complete enrollment @ WL between 1/10/23-1/24/23 via Sign-Up Genius
- <u>Step 6</u>: Bring completed enrollment packet and copies of all documents to office during scheduled time
- **Step 7**: Schedule for kindergarten screener during registration appointment
- **Step 8**: Parent notification in spring
- **Step 9**: Follow instructions on parent notification letter



PERMIT PROCESS



INTER-DISTRICT PERMIT:

- All families residing outside of SCUSD boundaries
- Approved permit must be included with completed enrollment packet AND to SCUSD Enrollment Center
- Tip: Request permit ASAP from home district

INTRA-DISTRICT PERMIT:

- All families residing within SCUSD boundaries but William Land is not your school of residence
- Completed intra-district permit must be included with completed enrollment packet AND to SCUSD Enrollment Center
- Intra-District Permit for the MIP Program is available in the William Land school office
- Tip: Register at school of residence as well

TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL YEAR




- Ensure your emails and phone numbers are accurate with teacher and office

Habits 1-7



Habit 1: Be Proactive®

I am a responsible person. I take initiative. I choose my actions, attitudes, and moods. I do not blame others for my wrong actions. I do the right thing without being asked, even when no one is looking.

Habit 2: Begin With the End in Mind®

I plan ahead and set goals. I do things that have meaning and make a difference. I am an important part of my classroom and contribute to my school's mission and vision. I look for ways to be a good citizen.

Habit 3: Put First Things First®

I spend my time on things that are most important. This means I say no to things I know I should not do. I set priorities, make a schedule, and follow my plan. I am disciplined and organized.

Habit 4: Think Win-Win®

I balance courage for getting what I want with consideration for what others want, When conflicts arise. I look for a win-win solution.

Habit 5: Seek First to Understand. Then to Be Understood®

I listen to other people's ideas and feelings. I try to see things from their viewpoint (paradigm). I listen to others without interrupting. I listen with my ears, my eyes, and my heart. I am confident in voicing my ideas.

Habit 6: Synergize®

I value other people's strengths and learn from them. I get along well with others, even people who are different than me. I work well in groups. I seek out other people's ideas because I know that by teaming with others, we can create better solutions than what any one of us could alone. I look for Third Alternatives.

Habit 7: Sharpen the Saw®

Leat right, exercise, and get enough sleep (body). I learn in lots of ways and lots of places, not just at school (brain). I spend time with family and friends (heart). I take time to find meaningful ways to help people (soul). I balance all four parts of myself.
