#### Course Description – All Classes

- 1) The curriculum applies a combination of synchronous (online zoom meeting) and asynchronous (offline) modes. The online class will be meeting with the teacher and no more than 20 students for a 40-minute class period.
- Synchronous classes will meet once per week via Zoom Meeting using the assigned class code. Classes will be tailored to students instrument choice and experience level.
- 3) The asynchronous mode will consist of weekly written and recorded playing assignments that the student will turn in. The Music Director will provide feedback to the students on both written and playing assignments. Upon completing certain playing assignments, students will receive our Mandarins Music Academy Karate Belts. After receiving the purple belt, students are then eligible to participate Honor Band.

4) The Mandarins Music Academy will once again employ the Sound Innovations curriculum. Book is included in tuition. This program is especially well suited for asynchronous self-study because of it's online accompaniment capability. Every exercise can be played on a computer or cell phone and the student can play along with the metronome (beat) and in some cases accompaniment. There are also numerous videos available ranging from how to assemble, care for and play an instrument.
