



Course Title: Introduction to Yangqin and Guzheng for Elementary School Students

Course Description:

This 18-week course is designed to provide elementary school students with a comprehensive music education experience, covering the Yangqin and Guzheng, two traditional Chinese musical instruments. - Learning Yanggin and Guzheng music symbols and sheet music reading.
- Performing a variety of pieces.
- **Weeks 11-12:** Advancing Yangqin and Guzheng Techniques
- Mastering higher-level Yangqin and Guzheng playing techniques.
- Performing a wider range of pieces.
- **Weeks 13-16:** Contemporary Yangqin and Guzheng Music
- Exploring the world of contemporary Yangqin and Guzheng music.
- Performing modern Yangqin and Guzheng pieces.
- **Weeks 17-18:** Yangqin and Guzheng Performance Projects
- Students select and prepare a Yangqin and Guzheng performance project.
- Implementing and showcasing the projects.

- Yangqin hammers and Guzheng nails.
- Music stands.
- Yangqin and Guzheng sheet music books.
- Audio and video resources for learning and listening to Yanggin and Guzheng music.
